


Is history, culture and tradition

Within its natural environment, prehistoric, Roman, Arabic and medieval remains shape the special character of this place, with its fascinating historical and cultural heritage.

Its cobbled streets, ancient buildings and small squares offer a welcoming atmosphere, a legacy of its strong artisan tradition, which, along with the extensive annual calendar of cultural and traditional events, means visitors can discover the true essence of the place.

Museums, art galleries, musical, theatrical and literary competitions, art exhibitions, popular festivals, artisan and culinary fairs all form part of one of the island's fullest events calendars, and there is always something on throughout the year.











Is beach and sport

Alcúdia has one of the best bays in Europe for practising water sports, with ideal wind conditions and first-rate facilities, both on land and in the water, for amateurs and professionals. The range of water sports on offer is endless: snorkelling, diving, water-skiing, all forms of sailing, kayaking, windsurfing, paddle surfing, kite surfing and fishing.







Is sea and fun

Large pine forests, huge stretches of fine white sandy beaches and small coves with crystal clear waters represent the treasures of a coastline that extends for 30km, dotted with 18 beaches with different characteristics. At each beach you will find all manner of options: from complete relaxation to a wide variety of leisure and sporting activities.





An oasis for nature

Nature continues to reign in this corner of Mallorca. Much of the area consists of protected zones with interesting native flora and fauna.

You can explore our mini paradise through 12 walks that take you through little known locations, along special paths, offering impressive panoramas. The routes cover the coast, hills and marshland, with the intense blue of the Mediterranean as a constant backdrop.

It is impossible to visit Alcúdia and not see birds. Thanks to the wide variety of habitats and specially protected areas, throughout the year we have more than 200 species of marine, coastal, urban, forest, farmland, mountain and wetland birds, some common and ubiquitous and others rare and localised.

Alcúdia Auditorium

Alcúdia Auditorium offers all the necessary facilities for holding theatrical, music and dance performances, cinema showings, cultural celebrations and artistic events, conferences and congresses. Standing on a 3500 m2 plot, the geometric building covers more than 2000 m2 and houses a theatre with capacity for 477 people.

The building contains the main theatre with stalls and a dress circle, a press room, 7 seminar rooms, an office, one multipurpose room with capacity for 50 people, a reception and an office for administrative services. It also has 2 double dressing rooms (for groups) and 2 small dressing rooms, simultaneous interpreting booths and a large vestibule with a reception service.

Can Torró Library

The old Can Torró mansion has been restored and fully equipped for its new social function. The neighbouring building of Can Fondo, another architectural jewel dating back to the fourteenth century, has recently been added as part of the complex. Their patios have been joined and one place complements the other in their role of promoting culture and the arts.

Pont de la Vila Roja

Work on Alcúdia's medieval walls began at the start of the fourteenth century and was not completed until the end of the same century. The quadrangular structure reaches an average height of 6 metres and has 26 watchtowers positioned along the 1.5km perimeter, as well as a moat that still exists. The walls surround the old historical centre of Alcúdia and were declared an Artistic and Historical Site of Interest in 1974, along with the remains of the Roman city of Pol·lèntia.

Located by the "Pont de La Vila Rotja", in part of the old moat, an amphitheatre has been created for holding events.

Capacity of amphitheatre: 300 pax.


